Community Compassion Meets Critical Need

This momentum is a testament to our community's compassion and commitment to ensuring no one faces homelessness alone. But we're not at the finish line yet, and the need has never been more urgent. COVID-era funding has ended. Federal help isn't coming. Our work now depends entirely on the financial support of neighbors like you who believe that housing is a human right.



Why Your Support Matters Right Now

The crisis is escalating. As homelessness rose substantially in Kane County in 2024, our drop-in visitors surged from 300 monthly to nearly 500 in August alone. Last year, we provided over 12,000 nights of shelter while our no-barrier drop-in lobby served meals, hygiene kits, and relief from the weather daily from 7am to 9:30pm. Without our programs, more families end up sleeping in their cars or on the street. More veterans slip through the cracks. More people facing health crises and disability have nowhere to stay tonight. More children go without a safe place to sleep.



In the past five months alone, 16 guests have successfully transitioned to sustainable housing. For many, the path home starts at PADS of Elgin—where they show up and find a community committed to showing up for them.

The most powerful moment of the day came when one of our current guests—a veteran—stood before the crowd and shared his story. Out of respect for his privacy, we asked that no one record his speech, and every single person in that room honored that request. In the quiet reverence of that moment, we were reminded why this work matters so deeply.

He spoke about finding community support within our shelter during the renovation. As he helped renovate the building, he realized he was renovating himself too—rebuilding his life alongside the walls being transformed around him. There wasn't a dry eye in the room. His courage to share, and his journey from crisis to hope, embodied the heart of PADS of Elgin's mission.




